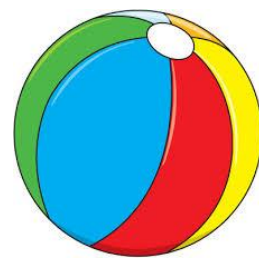




SUMMER ENRICHMENT

Math

- Practice addition and subtraction facts. Have someone say problems aloud or study flash cards.
- Make a "store" with real or play money and price things to be "bought"!
- Use the two numbers on Dominoes or roll a dice to make addition or subtraction problems.
- Keep track of the clock for one day. What time do you eat breakfast, lunch and dinner? How long does it take you to clean your room, brush your teeth, etc?
- Get out a ruler and measure ten things in your house.
- Count to 100 and then try to count backwards from 100!
- Count by 2's, 3's, 5's, and 10's
- Look at a hundreds chart and practice looking at numbers that are one 1 less, 1 more, 10 less, and 10 more.
