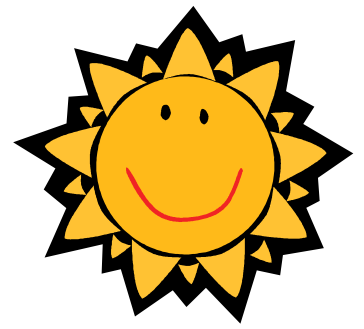


HCS Summer Enrichment Third Grade

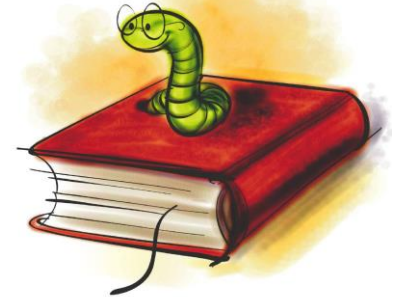
